

Northwestern Team Notes

- National Rankings: UNW Volleyball has been ranked in the AVCA's Top 25 every week of the 2023 season. The Eagles have never been ranked below the #6 spot in the country and have been as high as #3 in the country. The Eagles are currently ranked #5 in the country. UNW has also been the top ranked team in Region IX in every version of the NCAA's Regional Rankings this season.
- Milestones: Abby Glanzer surpassed 1,000 career kills this season and Kiera Brown surpassed 400 career blocks. Senior Libero Marylyn Schroyer became the 10th player in the history of NCAA Division III Women's Volleyball to record 3,000 career digs this season. Head Coach Beth Wilmeth won her 500th career game at UNW this season. She is the all-time winningest coach in school history, and the only one to surpass 500 career wins.
- Consistency:
 - The Eagles won their 13th straight UMAC Regular Season Championship this season
 - The Eagles won their 5th straight UMAC Tournament Championship this season
 - The Eagles are in their 12th NCAA Division III National Tournament in program history
- Can the Eagles get back to the Final Four?
 - UNW has been to two NCAA Division III Final Fours in program history (2016 and 2022). The Eagles made the final four last season and are looking to make a return trip in 2023
- Success against nationally ranked teams:
 - UNW is 5-2 against teams that were nationally ranked at the time of the match
- The Eagles are 4-0 this year against teams that were receiving votes in the national poll at the time of the match
