UW-Whitewater Team Notes

- The Warhawks are making the team's 34th appearance in the NCAA Tournament
- -UWW is 51-32 in the NCAA Tournament (first DIII appearance, 1986)
- -The Warhawks won the NCAA DIII title in 2002 and 2005
- -Coach Boudreau has led UWW to the NCAA Tournament 17 of 18 seasons the championship has been held during her tenure (including a national title her first season 2005; the 2020 season was canceled)
- **How We Got Here:** UWW received the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference's automatic bid into the postseason after defeating No. 2 UW-Oshkosh in the conference tournament championship
- Accolade Sweep: UW-Whitewater swept all the major player awards for the WIAC this season ... Outside hitter Jenna Weinfurt was named the Offensive Player of the Year, libero Morgan Jensen claimed Defensive Player of the Year honors and setter Aubrie Krzus was selected as the league's Newcomer of the Year. Middle hitter Kirsten Anderson added First Team All-WIAC honors In addition, Jensen was named the WIAC Judy Kruckman Scholar-Athlete of the Year
- One of the Best in DIII: Head Coach Stacy Boudreau recorded her 500th win at the helm for UWW. Win number 500 came on a sweep of Elmhurt on the Warhawks home court on September 29. She currently ranks among the top 10 all-time in Division III for win percentage.
- **Digging Up National Honors:** Libero Morgan Jensen recorded her 2,000th career dig this season. Her now 2,216 career digs is fifth in the UWW record book
- Jensen is coming off of a phenomenal week with 53 digs and three aces in six sets played -- an average of over eight digs per set. Jensen's performance was recognized nationally as the AVCA selected her as the National Player of the Week for Division III. This is her second time earning National Player of the Week honors (Sept. 14, 2021)
- **Hitting a Milestone:** Outside hitter Jenna Weinfurt reached the 1,000 career kill milestone this season. She heads into the regional with 1,103 career kills ranked 15th in the program record book
- **Record-Breaker:** Middle hitter Kirsten Anderson, the nation's leading blocker, has posted 148 total blocks in 2023 to set the single season program record that had been in place since 2016

- **Blockwater:** The Warhawks lead Division III in blocking with 2.74 blocks per set. UWW is ranked second in the nation in total blocks
- **Convention Time:** Morgan Jensen will be a demonstrator at the AVCA Convention in Tampa Bay in December of 2023 as part of a scholarship
